Waves and Fountains

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Waves and Fountains is filled with water images: flowing, trickling, dripping, churning. The first inspiration for the piece came from a musical motive I had created for my opera-in-progress *Melete*. Through the efforts of the heroine, a magical fountain reappears, bubbling up through the broken pavement that had buried it. The rushing, upward scale in measure 10 and flowing lines that follow come from that initial idea. The lines flow both up and down, crossing as waves from different directions amplify each other. The water imagery is important because it gave a flowing consistency to the piece, even as the textures and mood change.

Another unifying factor is the diminished scale. I didn't use it strictly, but it influenced the melodies and enriched the harmonies when I didn't want explicit major or minor sounds. A diminished scale is made of alternating minor and major seconds, so that groups of four notes that begin with a half step (for example, C, Db, Eb, E) contain both a minor and major third. In the final section, the harmony contains both intervals. You may hear it as a pleasing clash or an unresolved tension within an essentially serene, gentle passage.

I was very pleased to write this piece for Trio Arundel, knowing that they would negotiate the rhythmic complexities with ease. In some sections, I used note groups of 3 and 5 to create a notated rubato for semi-independent melodies without a strict pulse. Each part has its own expressive flow but the parts are coordinated so that larger phrases evolve together.

Trio Arundel played the first performance in September 1997 in Wilmington, Delaware.
